

A message from Malcolm

GOOGONG'S PROJECT DIRECTOR

Development at Googong is proceeding albeit at a slower pace as the impacts of COVID-19 are felt in the local economy.

Two new stages of subdivision, Neighbourhood 2 Stages 3 & 4, were completed in April with the roads now open to the public and 88 new lots ready to build on.

These stages included Googong's new main entry road, Wellsvale Drive, which opened to traffic on 20 April. Installation of a large new entry feature is scheduled for May.

Our sales team has relocated to a new (temporary) sales office on Courtney Street, in the heart of the new display village with new homes opening progressively as they are completed.

Construction within the Googong Common North sports and recreation precinct is nearing completion and is due to open in the next few months. The first stage of development within this precinct will see the establishment of six outdoor netball courts, public toilet block, a temporary bike pump track, boardwalks across Montgomery Creek linking the sports precinct with the existing path system within the Common, BBQ facilities and off-street parking.

The carpark and netball courts has been surfaced with a product called Reconophalt, Australia's first asphalt product that contains high recycled content from materials such as soft plastics, glass, toner and reclaimed roads.

A kilometre of road (two lanes) paved with Reconophalt can contain 500,000 plastic bags and packaging equivalents, 165,000 glass bottle equivalents and toner from 12,000 used printer cartridges. The carpark and courts will serve as a trial for the product in the hope that it can be used more widely on the remaining roads at Googong.

The Googong Township / Molonglo Conservation Group \$1m co-funded Pink-tailed Worm Lizard Saving our Species initiative continues with the installation of a perimeter fence to start soon. Other works include establishing and improving habitat for the species in specific areas, weed management, native grass improvement and creating an education sanctuary with the installation of walking trails which will be used by the Molonglo Conservation Group for guided tours.

There are now about 1,650 homes occupied with the population just tipping over the 5,000 mark. We really are becoming a township!

Learning from the Governor-General


Extended hours



ICON WATER

While the COVID-19 pandemic has meant many of us have spent a lot more time at home, and are now looking for every opportunity to get some time out in nature, it's a good time to remind residents of the Googong Township, of the special role that Googong Dam and its foreshores play.

Googong Dam's main function is to supply water for the urban areas of the ACT and Queanbeyan — it is the single largest reservoir in the ACT and region's water supply system, holding 119.4 gigalitres (GL, or 119,400 million litres).

Keeping this precious source of drinking water safe means there are some things we can and can't do in and around the dam so you can still enjoy the area while protecting drinking water quality for the community (see table below). Googong is a unique and precious resource for all, so we need to look after it and protect our drinking water.

After all the wet weeks we've had over this last month, you might expect that the Googong dam is a lot fuller. We've been very fortunate to receive some rain throughout April and early May, and with the supplementation of the Murrumbidgee to Googong Pipeline, we've seen Googong dam levels increase



from 41% to 45.5%. Overall the four dams that supply the ACT and Queanbeyan region are now at 51%. The winter predictions from BOM forecast more rain this winter compared to previous years. If we continue to work together as a community to care for water, and we do see this rainfall over winter, we can expect to see some significant changes in our water storage levels.
