A message from Malcolm

GOOGONG'S PROJECT DIRECTOR

Development Update.

Our construction team are flat out building the roads and services to create the lots that we've sold to new (and upgrading) Googonians over the past 12-18 months. The last six stages of Googong Central are under construction and they will all be finished within the next 6-7 months.

We are anticipating approval of the DA for the future neighbourhoods 3, 4 and 5 in September and construction work commencing before Christmas.





Googong Town <u>Centre.</u>

Following on from the informal virtual community information session held in August, the DA for the first stage of the Town Centre will be lodged in September. Council will publicly exhibit the application and will invite formal feedback from the community.

The new water supply reservoir at Nangi Pimble is now at its final height with the last concrete pour occurring in August. Work has commenced on doubling the capacity of the Water Recycling Plant to accommodate the ultimate population of Googong and is expected to be complete by September 2023.

Construction of Bunyip Park is nearing completion with the lake side decks, performance stage, shelters and play structure now complete with minor ground works left. This is an exciting project that has been challenging to construct through COVID, and it will be a beautiful space adjoining the future town centre.

Running parallel with Bunyip Park construction and sitting proudly over Bunyip Billabong, is the new permanent sales office. The building is now complete with only external landscape and carpark works left before a Certificate of Occupation can be sought. We expect both Bunyip Park and the doors to the sales office to open in October 2022.

The latest two sporting fields, sports field 3 and 4, have settled in nicely and are looking forward to some warmer weather to start the growing season off strongly. Soft landscaping around both fields is complete with a view to open both fields in Spring. The skatepark is also complete with the full-sized basketball court, public WIFI, DJ booth, shelter, cricket net facility and kickabout area included in the list of activities in this area. As mentioned above, whilst these two areas are complete, there are still hazards within the construction fence and we ask all Googonians to respect the fences and refrain from trespassing. We are as excited to open these areas as you are to use them but please be patient for a few more weeks!!

The Rotary Club funded the Googong Exercise Loop along Montgomery Creek which was opened on a rainy day in August by Mayor Winchester. We would like to take this opportunity to thank the Rotary Club and Glascott Landscape and Civil for their contribution. Importantly the loop provides for non-organised, incidental activation within the diverse community of Googong.

There are now about 2,130 homes occupied, with the population standing at around 6,300.

GOOGONG ON TRACK WITH SPORTS PRECINCT ADDITION.

Expansion of Googong's sporting precinct continues with the unveiling of a new 1.5-kilometre fitness loop, which includes six new exercise equipment sites.

The project was funded by the township and the Rotary Club of Jerrabomberra and Googong, joining the community's extensive sports precinct which is home to a 320-metre BMX track, six netball courts and more.

Googong Project Director Malcolm Leslie said the new fitness loop transforms the area by offering a one-stop venue for sport and physical activity.

"We're proud to partner with the Rotary Club of Jerrabomberra and Googong on the new equipment. Without the support and additional funding from the Rotary Club, this wouldn't have been possible," said Mr Leslie.

"We want to foster a tight-knit community and get the people of Googong together to enjoy everything our township has to offer, and this new fitness loop does just that. It's critical to supporting the health, wellbeing and community connection within Googong, providing residents with countless health and social benefits. With its new balance beam, parallel bars, step-up station, aerobic cycle, sit-up station and multi-use bench, the loop will no doubt prove popular with people of all ages, fitness levels and abilities."

The need for a fitness loop was based on community feedback after a consultation led by the Rotary Club of Jerrabomberra and Googong. Significant funding for the project was also secured through the Rotary Club's network.

The Rotary Club of Jerrabomberra and Googong President John Askew said the fitness loop provided an important place for the community.

"We aim to fund projects that respond to real community needs, like the need for an outdoor recreational space dedicated to health and fitness. To understand what the community needed, we completed a letterbox drop of Googonians for feedback and held a fundraising drive to deliver the loop. By working with Googong and Council to bring this fitness loop to life, we have been able to create something that everyone can enjoy, and that speaks to our goal of creating a fun and vibrant community," Mr Askew said.

The fitness loop adds to the growing sports precinct which will include an Indoor Pool and Sports Centre, netball centre, tennis centre, skate park, pitch and putt, BMX track, seven sports fields, and the Googong Sports and Recreation Club. The fitness loop is free to the public and will be maintained by Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council.

Mayor Kenrick Winchester said the new fitness loop is a great addition for the Googong community.

"It's awesome to see equipment that encourages people to get outside and be active. Projects like this really foster a sense of community and Council is glad to have helped bring this idea into reality," said Mayor Winchester.

The building has been impeccably designed by Clarke Keller Architects, with interior design by the Dept of Design, and construction by CapCorp.


The site is next to Googong's future town centre which, along with Bunyip Park, will become a focal point for the community in the coming years.

FUN FACTS FROM ICON WATER ABOUT THE GOOGONG FORESHORES

Impress your friends with these fun facts about the Googong Foreshores.

Googong Dam

- The Googong Dam and reservoir supply drinking water to our region.
- The Dam was completed in 1979, upgraded in 1995 and again in 2010.
- The dam wall is an earth and rock fill embankment with a clay core and a concrete chute spillway.
- The 66-metre dam can hold back 121,083 megalitres of water. This is almost equal to all of Icon Water's Cotter catchments combined.

Water Protection zone

Did you know the Dam wall, and surrounding fenced-off area, is managed under a 'water protection zone'? This includes critical infrastructure like our intake tower and water treatment plant. Shoreline access (e.g. for landing boats or fishing) is prohibited in this zone to mitigate the risk of polluting your drinking water.

Prohibition of watercraft access beyond the buoy line also protects visitors from physical hazards. Visitors must follow the water protection zone rules to ensure recreation continues to be permitted. These rules help protect water infrastructure assets and conserve this area's remarkable characteristics.

Please enjoy the Googong Foreshores safely and help us protect your drinking water.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU FIND INJURED WILDLIFE



Wildcare Queanbeyan Inc is a volunteer organisation that rescues sick, injured, and orphaned native wildlife. We then raise and rehabilitate the animals under our care for release back into their natural habitat.

If you find wildlife needing assistance, just call the **Wildcare Helpline on 6299 1966** and a rescuer will assess the animal and determine the best course of action. Add the number to your list of contacts so that you've got it when you need it. You never know when you might be able to help save a life!

It can also be helpful if you are able to take a photo of the animal from a safe distance without causing it unnecessary stress. Remember, injured animals can behave in unpredictable ways. Wildcare Queanbeyan is a not-for-profit charity which operates 24/7. It relies on donations to ensure the continued operation of the rescue and rehabilitation services.
