# A message from Malcolm

Demand for land at Googong continues to be strong. The construction of roads and services is in full swing with nine separate stages of subdivision underway. Construction of NH2 Stage 9A is nearing completion with the other stages to follow over the next 6 months.

Construction of Bunyip Park in Googong Central is well underway with most of the underground infrastructure installed. Over the coming months, retaining walls, lake side decks, toilet pod, shelters and a performance stage over the lake will start to take shape. You will also see our new permanent sales office spring up in this area. Detailed planning of the future neighbourhoods of Googong is well underway, with a development application to be lodged in September 2021. Whilst QPRC will formally seek comment on the application from the community, we also took the opportunity to present the submission to residents online in September in a joint initiative with the Googong Residents' Association.

Work on the latest sporting field, sports field 3, has commenced and will likely open early in the new year. It is primarily an AFL field but has been designed to enable a cricket pitch to be retrofitted in future. The works also includes concrete terrace seating with an undercover portion, flood lights and all-accessible path connections.

Work will commence on a skatepark in October, and we look forward to opening it early in the new year. The skatepark will have a great mix of beginner and advanced options to excite Googonians, especially the teenage variety. The skatepark even includes a full-sized basketball court, shelter, public Wi-Fi and an outdoor DJ booth!

Sports field 4 will commence construction in November with an opening date to align with sports field 3. Sports field 4 is a double rugby league and union field. It will include an informal 5-a-side mini soccer pitch and 4-pitch cricket net facility.

An artist has been commissioned to upgrade the existing Montgomery Creek boardwalk with a viewing deck, which will be encompassed by sculptural reeds. It will be a great spot for Googonians to rest and take in the view through the marshy creek line.

There are now about 1,950 Googonian homes occupied, with our population standing at around 6,000.



Work will commence on a skatepark in October, and we look forward to opening it in the new year.

# New principal for The Anglican School Googong as they plan rapid expansion.



Colin May is a highly regarded educator and experienced principal of more than four decades. His career has spanned primary, secondary, and outdoor education at a number of schools including St Andrew's Cathedral School and Trinity Grammar School.

Colin became the first male principal at Arden Anglican School in Beecroft and over a period of 17 years led the development of the school from a single primary school at Beecroft to a school with campuses in Epping and at Cambridge Business Park.

Colin was principal at Al Sadiq College from 2011 to 2014 and at the Italian Bilingual School in 2015, then assisted with enrichment programmes at the Kesser Torah College in 2016, which saw him honoured by the Teachers Guild of NSW with the award of an Honourary Fellowship (HFTGN). He was most recently the principal of the Sapphire Coast Anglican College from 2017 to 2018.

Throughout his career, Colin has prioritised the welfare of students and encourages each child to fulfil their potential by fully immersing themselves in the rich life offered by schools and their communities. We are pleased to announce Colin has been appointed as principal at The Anglican School Googong (TASG) from July 2021.

In 2021, TASG has 430 students K-10 and will have its first Year Twelve students graduate in 2023. A wide subject selection has been established in the senior years, to be delivered in brand new facilities at the school.


